Subject: Call for Proposals – Internally Funded Research Projects

The RDI Office of Kathmandu University invites faculty and researchers to submit proposals for **internally funded research projects** for the fiscal year 2025. This funding aims to promote research activities that contribute to academic excellence and organizational development while addressing institutional and societal priorities.

Funding Details

Category I

- Grant Amount: NPR 150.000
- Eligibility: Faculty members who have not received external funding for research in their departments.
- Number of Projects: 7

Category II

- **Grant Amount:** NPR 200,000 (from RDI) + NPR 200,000 (matching fund from respective schools)
- Eligibility: Faculty members conducting research with support from their schools.
- Number of Projects: 7

Important Guidelines

To ensure effective and impactful use of the limited funds, the following rules apply:

1. Personnel Costs:

 Personnel costs for Research Assistants (RAs) must not exceed 10% of the total project budget.

2. Seminars, Workshops, and Conferences:

 Costs related to attending or organizing seminars, workshops, or conferences will not be covered.

3. Focus Areas:

- o Budget utilization should prioritize research activities such as:
 - Purchase of essential materials, equipment, or consumables.

- Data collection and analysis.
- Prototype development or experimental work.

Submission Requirements

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. **Research Proposal**: Clearly outline objectives, methodology, expected outcomes, and alignment with university priorities.
- 2. **Detailed Budget Plan**: Include a breakdown of expenses, ensuring compliance with the funding guidelines.
- 3. **Timeline**: The project duration should not exceed December 31, 2025.

Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be assessed on:

- Alignment with Kathmandu University's strategic research priorities.
- Potential academic, social, and organizational impact.
- Feasibility, innovation, and effective resource utilization. In addition to that the project should be focused on:
 - Seed Funding Project (A project supported by initial, small-scale funding aimed at laying the groundwork for larger projects.)
 - *Proof of Concept (PoC)* (A small-scale experiment or implementation to demonstrate that an idea, theory, or method is feasible and has potential.)
 - Preparatory Research (Work conducted to establish the foundation for a larger study, such as initial data collection, framework development, or stakeholder analysis.)

January 31, 2025
